As well as this, we also discussed what inspired Mrs. Reynolds to be an architect and she mentioned that she never really thought about being an architect until she bought her first custom home. Before this, Mrs. Reynolds had her Bachelor's degree while her and her husband flipped homes and then sold them for a profit all over the country.
